

PREVENT THE SPREAD OF GERMS

The following will help prevent pet illnesses or bacteria from getting worse and possibly spreading to others:



- 1** Wash your hands regularly when handling pets.
- 2** Bathe and groom your pet regularly.
- 3** Don't allow pets and children to come into contact with each other's waste. Keep sandboxes covered when not being used to prevent animals using it as a bathroom.
- 4** Work with your vet to provide preventive products for parasites such as heartworm, fleas, ticks, and ringworm.
- 5** Wash your pet's bedding frequently.
- 6** Keep your pet up to date with their vaccination schedule for diseases such as rabies.
- 7** Scoop your cat's litter box daily. (Avoid the litter box if you have a compromised immune system or are pregnant.)
- 8** Any bite or scratch wounds from pets should be addressed immediately to prevent infection.
- 9** Wash and store your pet's food and water dishes from family dishes.
- 10** Have a pet health insurance plan for your pet. A pet owner and veterinarian can prevent certain diseases from occurring through vaccinations, while following certain rules to prevent other illnesses or bacteria from getting worse and potentially spreading to others.
